




Russian River looking downstream from Healdsburg

A comparison of longitudinal profiles between 1940 and 1991






River and pits just downstream of Hwy 101 in 1993



Pit breach in 1995 flood




Gravel pits and Highway 101 bridge. Caltrans put piers down an extra 60 ft. during seismic upgrade of bridge to account for pit capture






River is eroding the alluvium between the river channel and the pit
